Background



Intergraph

- Founded in 1969
- Leading global provider of engineering and geospatial software.
- Customers in more than 60 countries rely on Intergraph's industry-specific software to organize vast amounts of data into understandable visual representations and actionable intelligence.
- Intergraph has approximately 4,000 employees worldwide (as of 31 Dec 08) and generated 2008 revenue of \$808 million
- Approximately 60% of total sales are generated outside of the United States.





Background



Z/I Imaging

- Z/I Imaging was formed in 1999 when the Intergraph Corporation of Huntsville, Alabama and Carl Zeiss of Oberkochen, Germany combined there various assets pertaining to photogrammetry and remote sensing.
- Zeiss founded in 1848, is a world-renowned leader in precision machinery and optics and pioneered the science of photogrammetry.
- Intergraph pioneered the introduction of the computer-aided drafting as a platform for digital mapping system in the early 1970s and is now one of the world's leading computerized mapping companies.
- In 2002, Z/I Imaging became wholly owned by Intergraph. Zeiss remains a key supplier of custom optics for the DMC and RMKD digital cameras.



Z/I Imaging Today



Z/I Imaging today is operated as a separate global organization within Intergraph. Z/I receives the benefit of Intergraph's global presence and financial stability while retaining the responsiveness of a small company.




Z/I Imaging Today

Sensor Overview



Z/I Imaging will introduce the beginning of a new family of sensors in 2009. This new family will be based on single monolithic sensors with the highest photogrammetric characteristics in the industry. Follow-on products will be presented later in the week.

The RMKD is the first product in this new family of sensors. It is the first "metric" mid-format camera on the market.

The SSD storage and Z/I mount are common peripherals shared between the DMC, RMKD and future sensors.
